Shahab was a Council member of the Malaysian Institute of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators (MAICSA) between 1992-2007. He was president of the Institute in 2000 and 2001. He now sits on their Audit Committee and Membership Committee and previously also on the Law Review Task Force, Corporate Communications Committee and the Strategic Planning Task Force.

He is on the Investigation Panel of the Disciplinary Committee of the Bar Council of Malaya and he sits on SIRIM's board of directors. Shahab is a certified business coach and has a passionate interest in corporate governance and corporate directorship.
