- Graduated from University of Malaya with a Bachelor of Accounting (Honours) in 1990, Chew Hann is a Chartered Accountant (CA), registered with the Malaysian Institute of Accountants (MIA), and a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) with the Malaysian Institute of Certified Public Accountants (MICPA).
- Chew Hann started her career in international accounting firm Pricewaterhouse, before moving on to equity research, covering the Construction & Infrastructure, Banking, Transportation (Aviation, Shipping, Airport, Ports), Conglomerates and Consumer sectors in Malaysia.
- Her previous equity research attachments were with Standard & Poor's Malaysia, Affin-UOB Securities (later renamed Affin Investment Bank) and Peregrine Research (Malaysia).
- Chew Hann was voted Best Strategist for Malaysia in the 2016 Asiamoney Brokers Poll. In 2021, she was voted Best Analyst for Construction & Engineering in Malaysia in the Asiamoney Brokers Poll.
- Chew Hann's other achievements, since taking up the Malaysia Head of Research role in end-2010, was leading Maybank IBG's Equity Research Team to be the Top Ranking (No. 1) Research Team in Malaysia for 5 consecutive years (2015-19) in the Asiamoney Brokers Polls, and No. 2 for 4 sequential years (2011-14).
