

The **Annual Report** is more than just to meet regulatory requirements. It can provide investors and analysts with information about the company's operations and financial performance. To do this well, those preparing the Annual Report should have an understanding of what investors and analysts look for.



There are 2 parts to the programme. The first covers the concepts of fundamental analysis. The goal is to enable participants to understand the investors and analysts' information requirements. The second part covers the Annual Report message to investors and analysts. The goal is to have a document that meets all the "internal" information requirements of investors and analysts.

Through case studies, participants will be taken through a typical fundamental analysis. A comprehensive fundamental analysis will require both qualitative and quantitative information. The case studies will relate the information required to the relevant portion of the Annual Reports.

By the end of the programme, participants will have insights on how to improve their own company's Annual Report vis-à-vis investors and analysts.

Dato' Eu Hong Chew, aged 68 was previously the Deputy Chairman of I-Berhad. He was educated at the Royal Military College and possess a first-class honours degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Glasgow, United Kingdom. He holds a Master in Business Administration from the University of Bradford, United Kingdom.

He has been associated with the Sumurwang Group (the controlling shareholder of I-Berhad) as its Chief Executive with many years of experience including charting the path for Sumurwang's manufacturing arm, firstly under Dreamland Holdings Berhad and its subsequent venture into the steel business and the acquisition of I-Berhad.

As the CEO of i-Berhad since 1999, he oversaw the transformation of the Group from a digital appliance company into the developer of i-City. i-City is the first digital city in Malaysia and is today the heart of Selangor's Golden Triangle.

Prior to joining Sumurwang Group, he was with PA Management Consulting as a consultant for 10 years where he was also appointed Director of Studies for the Cranfield PA MBA Programme in Malaysia.

He is a self-taught value investor and has been investing in Bursa Malaysia and SGX companies from a value investment perspective for more than several decades. Apart from his value investment blog at i4value.asia, he contributes investment articles regularly for Seeking Alpha, Focus Malaysia and iProperty.com

His value investment experience has been enhanced by both his Board experience and his contacts with controlling shareholders of many Bursa Malaysia companies. These have given him a unique opportunity to be able to analyze and value companies differently from other research houses in the region.
