The meeting also serves as a forum/platform for shareholders to engage with Board directors to find out more about the company and raise questions and concerns.

This event will cover, among others, the requirements and rules governing/guiding AGMs and related matters, shareholders’ rights, observations at AGMs, practices that need to be addressed and best practices. As AGM represents a significant element of investor relations, it is, therefore, important for the PLC to manage shareholders’ expectations well and in this regard, it pays to anticipate and understand the type of questions and concerns shareholders are likely to raise at the AGM.
